





- Prestea and Bogosu (Golden Star) 13M oz's gold mined historically.
- Bibiani (Noble Minerals) 1.98M oz's gold; ~3M oz past production.



### Nangodi Main




- 1930s production averaged 26 g/t from +25K tons

Nangodi Gold Mine ca. 1947




## Nangodi Main Mineralization



### **Asafo Concession- Kibi Belt**




- **Eastern margin of Kibi Belt**


- Magnetic data reveals shears and newly identified intrusives





### **Key Projects – Asankrangwa Belt**




- Structural setting similar to Ashanti and Sefwi belt margins where Obuasi, Bibiani, Chirano gold deposits occur.
- Important cross structures align key deposits.
- Gold occurs at the intersection of cross structures with Asankrangwa structures.



### Golden Reef West

#### **Sample Data and Drill Plan**



- Soil samples define a 3 x 5 km anomaly along regional structures.
- Gold values in soil of ≥300ppb are common with values up to 3.6 g/t Au.
- Drilling results anticipated late Q3 2011.
